

To the parents with children in public day-care facilities

12. March 2020

Information about Corona virus in regard to the shutting down of daycare, day nursery and kindergardens.

Dear Parents

COVID 19 has created an exceptional situation in our schools and after-school programs. The government has decided that all schools and after-school programs will close beginning Monday the 16th of March and reopen Monday the 30th of March 2020. However, it is possible to receive necessity tending for you child, if you are required to work.

To the parents with children in public daycare facilities this means:

- That you must ensure tending of your child/children for the next two weeks, currently until Friday the 27th of March 2020.

Are you in need of necessity tending of your child?

If you are required to work with critical functions and have no other options for the tending of your child, it is possible to have them looked after in the following two weeks. Further information about what a critical function is, will follow at a later time.

We ask that you immediately try to find out which other options you have for child care the next two weeks, so that you can notify the daycare, day nursery and kindergardens regarding necessity tending, before 10 a.m. tomorrow, Friday the 13th of March.

The following applies to necessity tending:

- Requirements regarding "drop off/pick up times" will be stricter out of consideration for the child and safety
- Requirements regarding stricter hygiene for both adults and children still applies
- If your child is ill, it may not attend the public day-care facilities – remember to inform the facility.

If you are in doubt, please contact the management at your daycare.
